

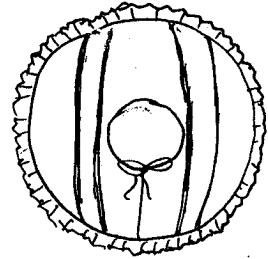


GREENBAUM'S
Quilted Forest

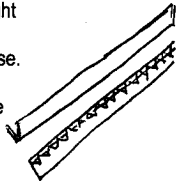
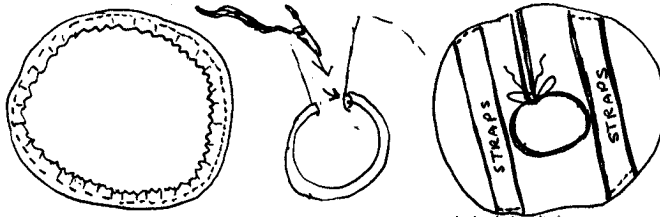
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CASSEROLE CARRIER

- 5/8 yd. fabric for outside
- 5/8 yd. fabric for inside
- 22" x 45" batting
- 3/4 yd fabric for ruffle, binding for straps and circle
- 3/4 yd. cord
- thread



1. Spray baste inside and outside fabric to batting. Practice your machine quilting as you quilt this 22 x 45" inch rectangle.
2. From this quilted piece, cut two 18" diameter circles. And, two 1 3/4" x 18" rectangles for the straps. Then cut a 6" circle out of the center of one of the big circles. Cut a straight line from the inner to the outer circle.
3. Cut (4) 3" x 45" strips for ruffle. Sew together in one long strip. Press in half lengthwise. Gather by loosening tension so thread can easily be gathered or ziz-zag over a cord, pulling on cord to gather. Adjust fullness of gathers to fit around the 18" circle with the ruffle facing in. Machine baste it to the whole big circle at just inside 1/2".



4. Cut (3) 1 1/4" x 45" straight strips for binding on straps and slash to circle. Bind both sides using 1/4" seams and single layer of binding.
5. Bind inner circle with bias binding. Cut 2 1/4" x 22" bias strip for this area or piece together a couple of strips. Sew on as for straps, single layer, 1/4" seam allowance. Start with a folded under straight cut and finish by turning under end before stitching it down. The cord will be threaded through this bias.
6. Place straps 1 inch away from inner circle, wrong side facing right of circle fabric. Baste to seam allowance of circle.
7. Place both circles right sides together. Stitch with a 1/2" seam allowance around the circle. Turn right side out.
8. Thread cording through the wide bias at the inner circle.
