### DYNO-BABY STROLER QUILT

- \_\_\_ 3/4 yd Center Print (this will make two quilts centers)
- \_\_\_ 1/6 yd (6") each border (I repeated top and bottom} 3/4 yd if one print
- \_\_\_ 1/2 yd binding
- \_\_\_ 1 3/8 yd 60" wide snugley/minkee for the back
- \_\_\_ One Craft Pack Quilters Dream Batting, the blue request weight package

Flannel ravel, use 1/2" seam allowances:

1. Cut the center in half on the fold, creating a piece approximately 21" x 27".
2. Sew a 6" wide border to each side of the center panel, then sew one to the top and bottom. If using the "numbers" print make sure they end up right side up.
3. Spray baste the quilt top to our lightest weight 100% Quilters Dream batting.
4. Then spray baste the snugley/minkee to the batting.
5. Drop the feed dogs on your machine, slip on the darning foot and stipple some swirls onto this quilt.
6. Trim excess batting and backing to the size of the front of the quilt.
7. Cut (5) 3" x width of fabric for the binding. Sew together and bind the quilt. Great directions for binding in any of Karla Alexander's books, complete with pictures.
8. Thoroughly dampen and put in dryer for 10 minutes to shrink and add texture to the stroller quilt.
