## BOOK REVIEWS

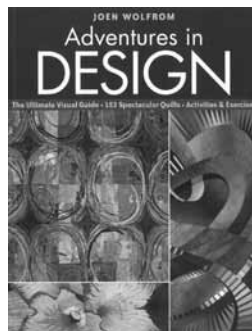


**SCRAP REPUBLIC 8 quilt projects for those who love color**, by Emily Cier, \$16.95.

Oh I love modern scrap quilts. Emily covers "gathering and sorting", "what color is it", "piecing ideas" and "uses for thread scraps"...What fun.. Then there are the colorful quilt samples with patterns divided into two chapters, "The Weekend Stasher for small and simple projects and "The I-Have-Nothing-to-Hide-Anymore Stasher" for larger and more complex projects. I'm inspired. Sally is teaching from this book this session if you want help or just a fun time.



**ADVENTURES IN DESIGN** by Joen Wolf from \$29.95  
 If you have any interest in art quilts or original designs this book will be your bible. Joen, the best in color presentation has now given us design info of the masters, organized in sections for setting the stage, creating the visual dance, and then designing spectacular quilts. Beautiful samples photographs and drawings. Excellent color and shape information even if you're not up for an original design. Pam is teaching from this book this session. You'll meet with her for a class before you choose fabric. Give it a try.



**FAITHFUL & DEVOTED To My Adelaide: A Quilted Love Story**, by Sarah Maxwell and Delores Smith. \$24.95

In 1861, a young man, Charles Tenney, began his service as a private in the Union Army. He traveled to the Mecca, Ohio home of his commander, Hal Case, where he met Hal's sister, Adelaide. As Tenny travels and experiences combat, he details daily life in a series of letters, Adelaide responds, and the friendship grows. The letters are from a collection donated to the University of Virginia in May of 2000, and provide a detailed look into day-to-day Civil War life. Interspersed between the letters are classic period blocks and quilts. If the darker tones of these quilts aren't your style, try them in your favorite fabric as most of our modern blocks have historic backgrounds. I'm engrossed in the story right now, the blocks will have to wait!



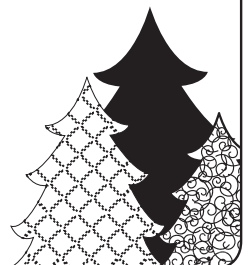
